
## **Events Survey Results**

44 responses were received to our Events survey which ran in July 2023 across social media, Kirton First community magazine and with links displayed in noticeboards across the town. Of the 44 responses, not everyone answered every question and the summary of the responses is shown here for each of the five questions asked.

Q1. What do you think of the Christmas Festival? (please do not include comments on the lights display, this survey is about the event only)



Of the 39 people who answered this question, it was clear that the most people (17 or 43.6%) thought there should be more market stalls at the Christmas Festival, however this was closely followed by a response of 16 (41%) people that the event is perfect as it is and doesn't need changing. No one responded that there should be less market stalls at the event. 5 people (13% of those responded) answered that there should be more fairground rides with 1 person responding there should be less.

Due to the location of the event and the requirements for emergency access to be maintained, the event is split across the Market Place and Sylvester Street. Kirton in Lindsey Town Council tries hard to encourage local businesses and organisations to support the annual community event and has worked with different providers for fairground provision over a number of years. The Town Council promotes the event locally to encourage local businesses to take up stalls and has worked closely with the Shop Local Pop-Up Market over the past two years to further promote local businesses for community events.

Q2. What do you think of the Summer Gala?

41 people left a response to this question, and the largest response, 13 people (32%) said that the event should be a bigger event held at KLASSIC Park. 10 people responded that there should be more business and food stalls at the Gala and that there should be more games and fun activities such as welly wanging, sports day races and Tug-Of-War etc. 8 people (20%) thought that the Gala should be a small event held on the Green. 0 people responded that they thought the Gala should be for community groups and charities only. The Summer Gala event was held at KLASSIC Park in 2023 for the first time as part of a joint anniversary event celebrating 10 years since the opening of KLASSIC Park. Each year, 'sports day' style races like running, egg & spoon, sack races and the tug or war take place as part of the advertised schedule of events. Business and food stalls are made available to book and the take up of these is unfortunately out of the control of Kirton in Lindsey Town Council, but work continues linking in the Shop Local Pop-Up Market to further promote and encourage the take up at community events.

## Q3.

What do you think of the one off events that are held? i.e. the Jubilee event & the Coronation. Do you think something like the Picnic on the Green should be held on a regular basis?

There were 37 responses about one-off events and if people felt they should be held more regularly. 9 people responded that they didn't think there should be regular one-off events planned for the town, while the remaining 28 people were interested in more one-off events to be planned.

A variety of ideas were put forward that can all be considered and the collective picnic idea was received very well. The Green was noticeably mentioned as was the importance of bringing the community together. Thank you to everyone who responded as your views are all taken into account.

## Q4.

What other events would you like to see held within the Town?

22 people left responses for other events which they would like to see held in the town. Open Gardens, Halloween/All Hallows/autumn event, Bonfire night, more for teenagers/teen hang out, music events, sporting events, food and drink events/beer festival, Easter events/spring events, bingo, running clubs, annual community get togethers, comedy nights, monthly mini market, farmers market, treasure hunts, summer clubs, outdoor cinema, Bloom/wildlife events, specific events for those with disabilities, Kirton's Got Talent were all suggested. All the suggestions can be looked at and considered. Thank you to everyone who put some forward.


There are number of cross over links which are already happening in the town, such as music events planned by Town Hall Live, sporting events through a wide variety of local groups and organisations, fitness clubs, running groups, quiz nights at the Town Hall, comedy nights at the local pubs, Kirton Rocks (rock painting/hide and find activity), and the monthly Shop Local Pop-Up Market.

The Town Council would not want to take away from organisations and groups who are already doing the things which more people want to see and take part in.

The organisation of events such as the Summer Gala and Christmas Festival takes months of work behind the scenes, with difficult decisions to be made, costs to be covered and many different parts to be planned and organised to come together.

We welcome your ideas and feedback at all times as these help us understand better what people like and don't like and bring new things forward for us to consider and to try to achieve. There is now an Events Working Group which focuses ideas and develops town events which people are invited to join in with as and when they would like, to bring ideas forward, develop them and get involved. There is no long-term commitment needed and you can come along whenever you'd like to.
