

CHILD PROTECTION AWARENESS TRAINING (1-DAY COURSE)

TARGET GROUP

Staff from voluntary agencies who have regular contact with children and parents, or carers who are not primarily responsible for child protection, but have some professional and organisational responsibility for safeguarding and promoting children's welfare.

AIM

To develop an understanding of working together to safeguard children and be familiar with the roles and responsibilities involved in promoting the welfare and protection of children.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course, participants should:

- Recognise and respond to concerns about a child;
- Appreciate their own role and that of others;
- Communicate and act appropriately within national/local guidance to safeguard children;
- Gain confidence to act on concerns about children;
- Have some basic awareness of legislation and guidance underpinning Child Protection processes;
- Know what to do if they have concerns about a child;
- Know what will happen once concerns have been referred.
