

CHILD PROTECTION FOUNDATION TRAINING (2-DAY COURSE)

TARGET GROUP

Staff from all agencies who work directly with children or adults who are parents, e.g. Health Visitors, Hospital Staff, Probation, Police, Education, Resource Workers and Voluntary Agencies who have particular responsibilities for safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children.

AIMS

- To enhance knowledge and skills and the ability to work together to safeguard and promote the welfare of children;
- To provide an opportunity for participants to learn together and explore professional dilemmas.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course, participants will have:

- An in depth understanding of how to take action and how to advise others if they have concerns about a child;
- An awareness of their own and other's designated responsibilities;
- Knowledge of the information process – understanding the principles and problems in information sharing – and be aware of protocols and procedures;
- An awareness of the issues and factors affecting inter-agency communications;
- An understanding of how to use professional judgement and analysis to inform assessment and decision-making;
- Familiarised themselves with the case conference purpose, process and outcomes – and understand their role and responsibility within the conference.
